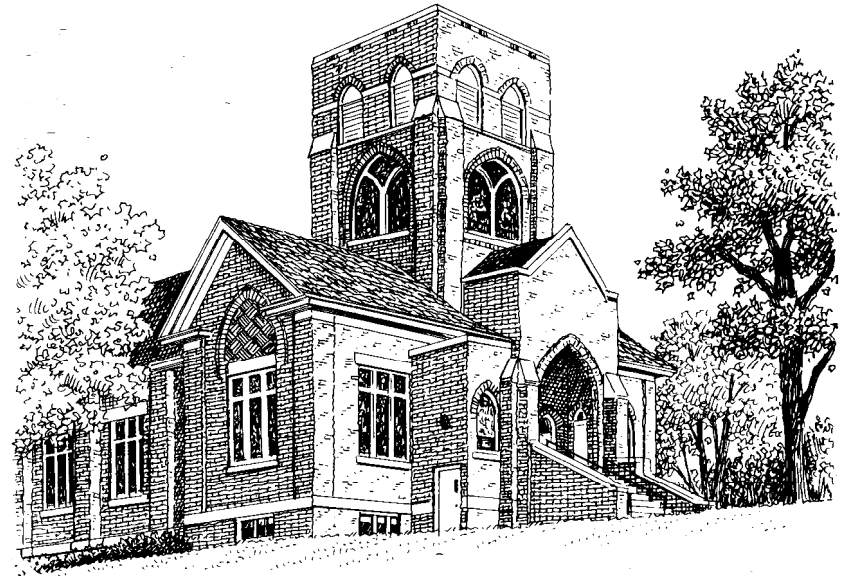

- 3). Cutting Boards for Rotary Cutters
- 4) See thru or Graph Rulers.
- 5). People willing to cut fleece on workday

March 7th after the meal adults and children will gather around tables and finish blankets finalizing the fringe. Everyone is welcome. We want adults helping children accomplish this project.
